	Lesson 2	Cosmetic Procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To assess and manage risks associated with cosmetic and aesthetic procedures, including tattooing, piercings, the use of sun lamps and tanning salons

	Lesson 3	"No" Means "No"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know how to seek consent and to respect others' right to give, not give or withdraw consent to engage in different degrees of sexual activity To recognise when others are using manipulation, persuasion or coercion and how to respond
	Lesson 4	Faith and Culture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To understand and respect others' faith and cultural expectations concerning relationships and sexual activity

	Lesson 2	Adoption and Fostering	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To understand the reasons why parents choose to adopt/foster or to place children for adoption / fostering
Core 3 Unit 1 In the Workplace	Lesson 1	Employment Patterns	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know about changing patterns of employment (local, national, European and global); about different types of business, how they are organised and financed
	Lesson 2	Work Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To research, secure and take full advantage of any opportunities for work experience that are available
	Lesson 3	Rights and Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know about rights and responsibilities at work (including their roles as workers, and the roles and responsibilities of employers and unions)
